Safeguards against airborne hazards, ensuring safe breathing in various environments.



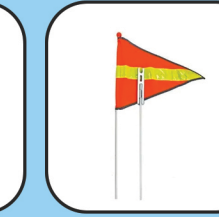
Foot Protection
